

JOB POSTING - FESTIVAL PRODUCTION ASSISTANT

The Toronto Sketch Comedy Festival Inc. is seeking two team members to fill the role of **Festival Production Assistant** for the 2018 TOsketchfest which takes place February 28th to March 11th, 2018. The Festival Production Assistants will provide production and logistical support to the annual comedy festival, performing a variety of tasks. This is a part-time contract from February 19th to March 13th, 2018.

The Festival Production Assistants will be key members of the festival team, working closely with the Managing Producer and Festival Manager.

Primary Responsibilities:

Core duties, deliverables, and relationships of the position.

The position includes the following duties:

- Execute the daily production to-do list, including deliveries, pick-ups, room set-ups, maintaining supplies and inventories;
- Assist with theatre load-ins and load-outs;
- Shuttle talent, volunteers and producers between airports, hotels, and Festival venues as required;
- Assist the producers with fulfilling hospitality and production riders for talent;
- Support the producing and technical teams as required with physical labour, driving, running errands etc.
- Distributing marketing and promotional materials, and/or materials for sponsors and VIP,
- Attending production meetings/training/post-mortem meetings where required.

Knowledge, Abilities and Skills Required

- Event/theatre production/festival experience required;
- Experience at TOsketchfest is an asset;
- Excellent organizational skills, task-management and ability to prioritize;
- Ability to take direction as well as take initiative when required;
- A great sense of humour and team-play.

Job Requirements

- Must be over the age of 18;
- Must have a valid class G driver's license and clean driver's abstract;

- Must have access to a clean and reliable vehicle with at least moderate storage capacity which can be used to perform the duties of this position. (Gas and parking will be reimbursed.)
- Knowledge of downtown Toronto, including geography, driving routes and the various resources/stores available;
- Ability to lift and carry approximately 50 pounds;
- Ability to work on a ladder;
- Ability to work a flexible schedule during the contract which could include a mix of daytimes, evenings, late nights and weekends;
- Must <u>NOT</u> be a performer in the 2018 Toronto Sketch Comedy Festival.
